Notice is hereby given pursuant to [M.G.L. c. 69, § 30](#) and the [Massachusetts Board of Higher Education's Policy Establishing a Process for Public Comment on Articles of Organization and Foreign Certificates of Institutions of Higher Education that the Massachusetts Department of Higher Education](#) will open a comment period relative to **the Articles of Amendment filed by the American University of Greece to offer the Bachelor of Science in Nutrition and Dietetics**

The American University of Greece (AUG) is headquartered in Boston Massachusetts. It is a non-profit institution of higher education, accredited by the New England Commission of Higher Education. AUG was established in 2021 and is authorized by the Massachusetts Board of Higher Education to award undergraduate, graduate, and honorary degrees. The AUG Global Campus represents an initiative that blends American education with Hellenic culture in an online learning environment. It offers fully online, American-accredited degree programs which serve as the institution's official U.S. degree-granting body. Academic programs are also delivered on the Athens campus through a validating agreement that ensures consistency in academic standards.

The public comment period for the Articles of Amendment filed by the AUG to offer the Bachelor of Science in Nutrition and Dietetics begins on June 2, 2026, and will close on June 21, 2026.
