## Approval of Criminal Justice Programs

### Background

Board staff have thoroughly reviewed materials submitted by the University of New Haven since the December review of its undergraduate program and have found that the materials demonstrate full compliance with all standards found within the *Guidelines for Criminal Justice and Law Enforcement Programs*.

With the approval of this additional program, 37 programs offered by 30 institutions are on the new approved program list for the Police Career Incentive Pay Program.
